

## 1. Introduction

To ensure the proper functioning of our website, we sometimes place small data files on your computer called “cookies”. Most major websites do the same.

## 2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. They enable the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) for a period of time so that you do not have to enter these preferences every time you visit the site or browse its pages.

## 3. How Do we Use Cookies?

### Example:

Some of our pages use cookies to remember:

1. your display preferences, e.g. brightness or font size
2. if you have already responded to a pop-up survey asking if the content was useful or not (so that the same question is not posed to you again)

Enabling these cookies is not necessary for the site to work, but they will allow you to have a better browsing experience. You can delete these cookies, or block them, but, if you do, some features of the website may not work satisfactorily.

The information associated with cookies is not used to personally identify you. The cookies are not used for purposes other than those described herein.
